Hazards of Common Art Activities

- Drawing
 - o Beware of fixative
 - Only use non toxic materials
 - Use only water based markers.
- Painting
 - O Do not use pigments that contain the following:
 - Antimony, Arsenic, Cadmium, Chromium, Cobalt, Lead, Manganese, and Mercury
 - Avoid oil paints even at the secondary level
- Printmaking
 - o Be sure all tools fit age and muscle control of students
 - o Demonstrate how to safely use cutting tools
 - Use water based, non toxic ink only
- · Fibers & Dyeing
 - o Be sure fibers have been sanitized
 - Wear dust mask when using powdered dyes
 - Use double boiler for wax melting
- Stained Glass & Jewelry
 - Use caution when cutting glass
 - o Wash hands thoroughly after using lead cane
 - o Don't not breathe fumes when soldering
 - o Have machine guards on grinding or polishing tools
 - o Give clear instruction on cutting metal or wire
 - Use cadmium free silver solders, and fluoride free fluxes, as well as lead free enamels
- Ceramics
 - o Do not breathe clay powder
 - Wet mop floor to avoid dust flying into the air
 - Wear mask specifically designed to filter silica
 - Do not use glazes which contain:
 - Lead, Arsenic, Cadmium, Nickel, Beryllium, Zinc Chromate, Selenium, and Uranium
 - When firing
 - Beware of extreme heat
 - Have proper ventilation for fumes
 - Understand the safety features of your kiln
- Photography
 - Have good ventilation
 - 10 air changes per hour for he darkroom
 - Avoid extremely toxic chemicals and processes
 - Wear gloves or use tongs when handling chemicals
 - o Keep chemicals covered when not in use
 - Clean up spills immediately

• Sculpture

- o Demonstrate proper use of cutting and power tools
- o Create safety tests for students before use of dangerous tools
- o Use extreme caution when welding, wear all necessary safety apparel

• General

- o Have good ventilation
- o Dispose of materials properly
- o Use gloves when handling hazardous materials
- o Use eye protection and protective clothing when necessary
- No horseplay
- o Do not allow food in the studio
- o Supervise
